



## Overview of the Training Course: **Bioethics**

In the frame of the WP4 (Work Package dedicated to the "Training of Trainers"), the training course in Bioethics intends to provide a useful tool for discussion and confrontation over sensitive topics that medical doctors face in their professional path. It foresees to provide attendees with the tools necessary to assess difficult situations with greater consciousness and open-minded attitude and criticism.

- 1) It will be delivered by prof. **Giovanna Ruberto**, MD and Associate Professor at the University of Pavia, Department of Public Health, Experimental and Forensic Medicine.
- 2) Classes will be delivered on Thursday, once every two weeks, Starting December 3<sup>r</sup> 2020; Time: 10:00 AM Italy 2.00 PM Tajikistan 2.00 PM Uzbekistan 3.00 PM Kazakhstan

Any change to the schedule will be agreed in advance.

**The first class will function as a preliminary meeting**, where the teacher will deliver more information on the course itself, its contents, and attendees will be able to agree with the teacher over some topics they may be particularly interested in tackling.

- 3) This kind of training is **destined to teachers**
- 4) The course will be delivered **in blended modality:** clinical cases and study materials will be provided in advance by email; live sessions will be foreseen to allow for direct interaction and guaranteeing the chance to discuss sensitive topics with professionals; Live classes will be stored and re-watchable if needed.
- 5) Classes will approximately last **1 hour each**.
- 6) There is no limit in the number of attendees
- 7) A final certificate of attendance will be released to all those people having attended at least the 75% of the course.

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- 8) The course will be held in **English**.
- 9) Given the peculiar and sensitive topics that the course is going to tackle, the course contents will be agreed class after class by the attendees, shaping the course according to their very needs and requests.
